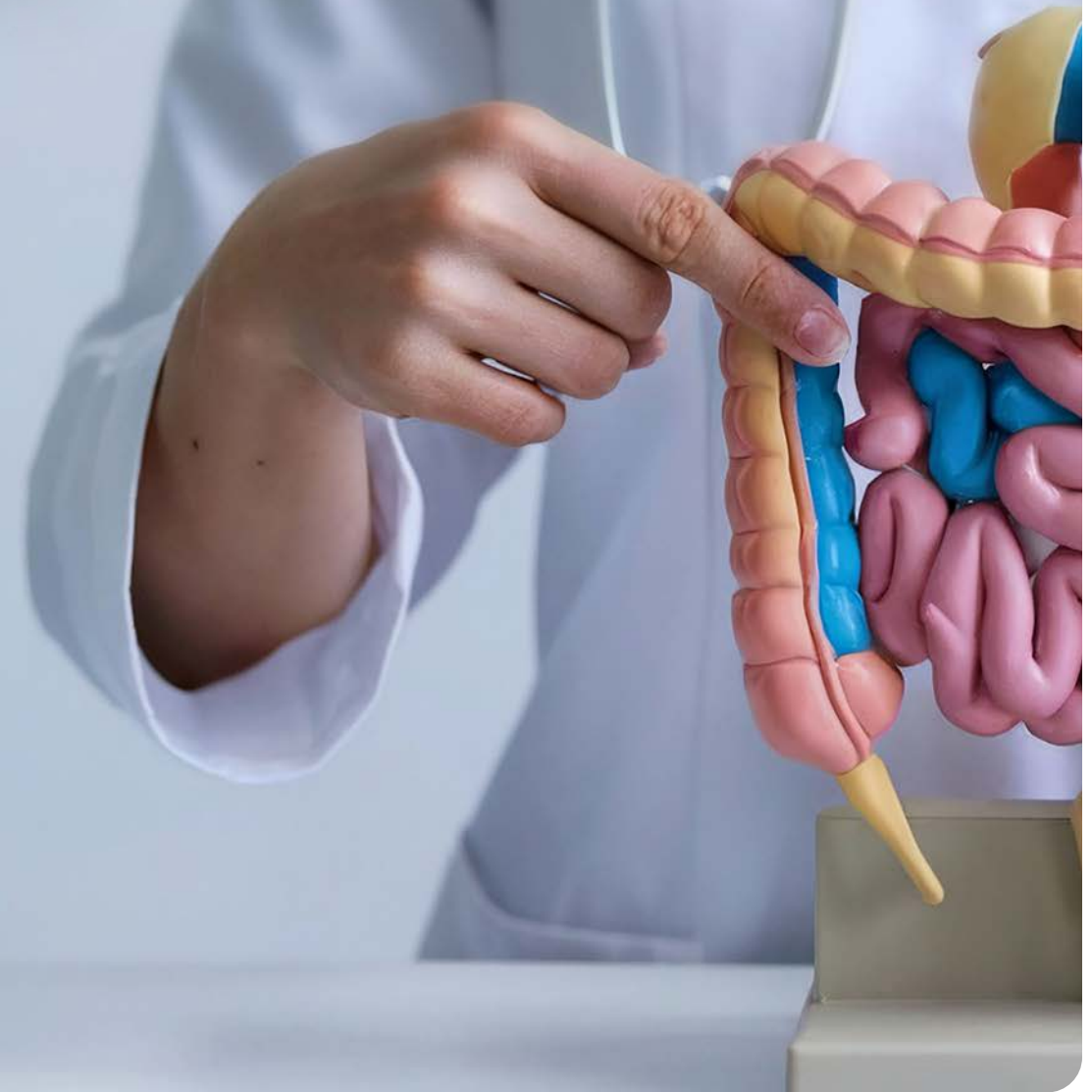

Robotic-assisted colectomies

Gastrointestinal issues may require various methods of treatment. Patients with colon cancer or other colon conditions may require a colectomy, which is the surgical removal of an extent of the colon. Samaritan surgeons are highly trained for colectomy procedures using the state-of-the-art da Vinci Robotic-Assisted Surgical System.

With just four to five fingertip-sized port holes, surgeons utilize robotic arms with 360-degree movement to remove the diseased section of colon — resulting in drastically less pain, quicker recovery, and shorter hospital stays.
